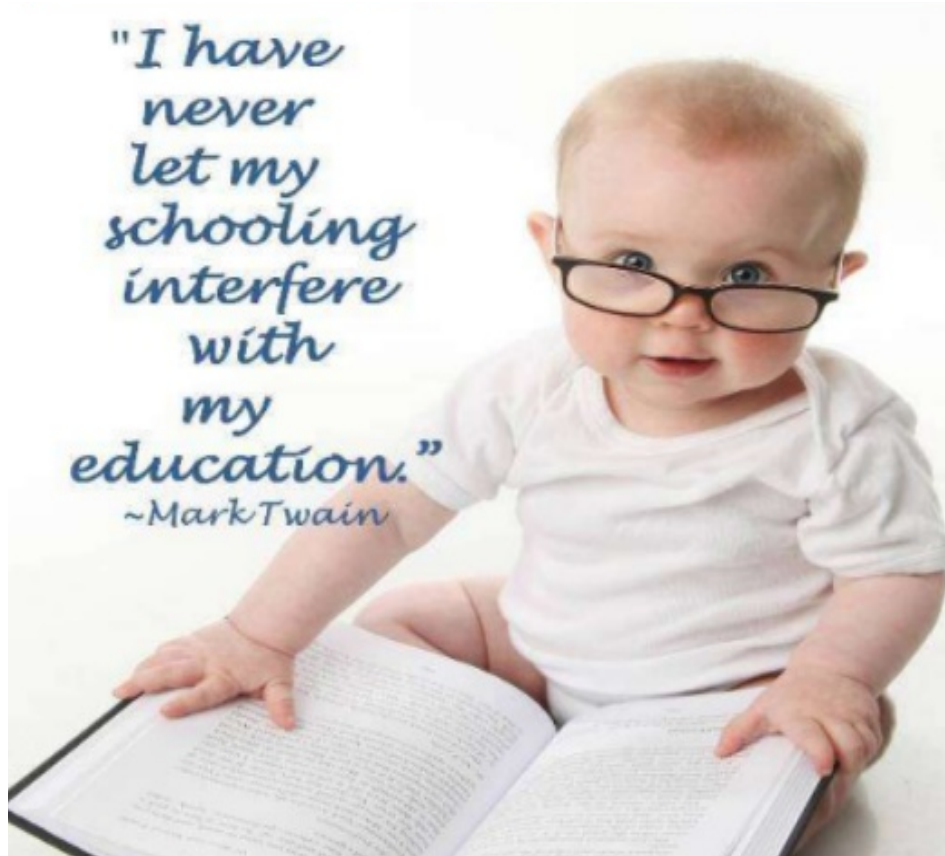
21C learning, SCL & Inclusion
